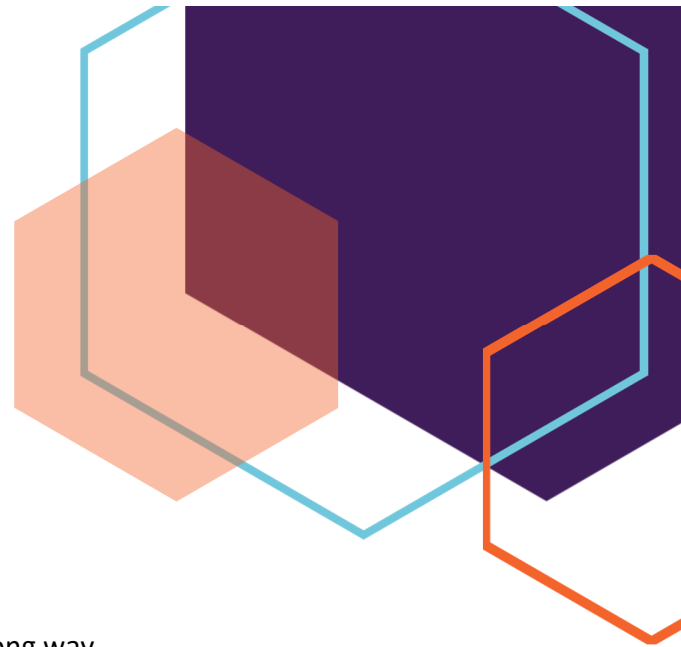


BISHOPS CAUNDLE COMMUNITY STORE
